

Please take the time to read this email as it contains a lot of information that is important for upcoming competition.

First, the show office hours are Tues 2 PM–6 PM; Wed 8 AM–6 PM; Thurs thru Sat 7AM–6:30 PM; Sun 7 AM–5 PM.

Stabling is posted on www.horseshowoffice.com along with day sheets, award schedule, ride times and whatever else I can think of. Many of you will be signing up for night watch and they will also get the stabling info. If you have questions about the stabling, please contact Kari directly at rkhotshoe@aol.com.

Remember stabling opens at 4pm on Tuesday. For those who paid for early arrival we will have your stalls available by Monday at 4pm. If you need early arrival please let me know by Friday, Sept 13th before midnight, so that I make sure your stalls will be ready. Sadly if you do arrive early and have not paid, your stall(s) may not be cleaned and you will be charged early arrival.

Shavings can still be ordered through me (not Kari) until Friday, Sept 13th before midnight. After that point, shavings can be ordered at the show office and you will need to pick them up. If you cannot remember if you ordered shavings or how many you ordered, you can find it on the stabling chart in the far right column.

If you are considering scratching your entire entry, your shavings will be refunded if I receive the scratch by Friday, Sept 13th before midnight (WOW! For a Friday the 13th it will be busy!!!). After that it is too hard to try to get them back into inventory with almost 800 stalls.

The schooling schedule is posted on www.horseshowoffice.com under the heading of Competitor Letter.

For those who still do not have classes, I need to know by Friday, Sept 13th before midnight if you want to (1) scratch the entry with full refund minus the office fee or (2) come as non-compete and fill in scratches at the show.

There are still a few VIP tables left. This is two hot meals, i.e. Breakfast and Lunch, Thursday thru Sunday at the show in the VIP Pavilion. Table of 8 is \$1000 and Individual seat is \$150/ea. Let me know again by Friday, Sept 13th before midnight...certainly a theme going on.

-Grounds open for schooling at 4 PM on Tuesday, Sept. 17, 2019

-Warm Up Areas Blue, Red, White, Yellow, Green and Lunging Area

Wednesday – Sept. 18, 2019

-Ring 1 and CDI On-Deck Area– Open from 8 AM until 2 PM. Open from 4 PM until 6 PM

-Rings 2 – 8 and Warm Up Areas Blue, Red, White, Yellow, Green and Lunging Area – Open from 8 AM until 7 PM

Thursday – Sept. 19, 2019 thru Sunday – Sept. 22, 2019

-**Hand walking** around outside of Rings 1 – 8 until 7:30 AM

-Areas in and around rings 1, 2, Blue Warm Up Area will be open for Riding from the end of Awards Ceremonies until 7 PM

-Areas in and around Rings 3 – 8 and Red, White, Yellow, and Green Warm Up Areas will be open from end of competition until 7 PM
