- Show will be run entirely **OUTDOORS**. Parking in field, please work off your trailer, no stalls in barn! Warm up is out-doors, as is the arena.
- **Please bring only 1 other person with you to help/coach/groom etc.**
- There will be no food or beverages. Water spigot by field.
- Porta-John, with bottle of disinfectant spray.
- **Unmounted persons must wear a mask.** Please observe social distancing, at least 6 ft from any other person.
- Please do not enter the barn.
- All entries will be online ([www.horseshowoffice.com](http://www.horseshowoffice.com)) **ONLY** prepaid by PayPal or online check only. All documents must be uploaded to [www.horseshowoffice.com](http://www.horseshowoffice.com), emailed to [entries@scriptsrides.com](mailto:entries@scriptsrides.com) or fax to 540-301-8166. No paperwork will be excepted at the show! You must have a complete entry (all paperwork and payment) to receive ride times. Paperwork needed: Signed Entry form, Current Coggins Test & Current Flu/Rhino Vaccine Record.

- Number of rides will be limited to 30 to allow time for everyone and not have the warm-up crowded. Effort will be made to have your rider times within 30 minutes of each other to encourage limited time on the grounds. If you need more time, please put this on your online entry in the notes.

- Tests \$35 per test/ride

**This document waives important legal rights. Read it carefully before signing.**

I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily with my horse(s) as a rider, driver, handler, less agent, coach, trainer, or as parent or guardian of junior exhibitor in any equine activities in this Virginia Dressage Ass Charlottesville Chapter ("VADA-CH") sponsored show which is sanctioned as a United States Dressage Federation regional awards schooling show at Cedar Creek Stables (hereinafter "Farm"). In consideration of my/my daughter's participation in any equine activities sponsored by VADA-CH at Farm, I hereby release and waive my rights and the rights of any of my insurers by subrogation to sue VADA-CH, USDF, their board members and officers and volunteers, and Farm's owners, employees, agents, and/or representatives for any loss, damage, injury, or death to person or property sustained by me/my daughter/son in equine activities by any cause whatsoever, including: (1) the intrinsic dangers of the activity and the propensity of an equine to behave in dangerous ways; (2) the inability to predict an equine's reaction to movements, objects, persons, or animals; (3) hazards of surface or subsurface conditions, whether known or unknown; (4) the experience level of any participant in equine activities at Farm; (5) a known or unknown health condition of any participant in such equine activities (including communicable diseases) ; and (6) the condition and age of the equipment or tack; and any other which may result in loss or injury such as, but not limited to: the potential for serious bodily injury (including broken bones, head or neck injuries), sickness and disease (including communicable diseases), trauma, pain and suffering, permanent disability, paralysis and death; loss or damage to personal property (including my mouth and equipment) arising from the unpredictable behavior of horses; exposure to extreme conditions and circumstances; accidents involving other participants, event staff, volunteers or spectators; contact her collision with other participants and horses, natural or man-made adverse weather conditions. I assume all the foregoing risks and any other dangers intrinsic to equine activities and accept complete responsibility for making any and all examinations or inspections relating to those risks and any other potential risks of recreational activities, and I agree and understand that VADA-CH, USDF, and Farm shall have no responsibility whatsoever to make any such examinations or inspections. I further assume all risk of, and agree to hold harmless Farm and its employees, representatives, or agents, or on the part of any other person with regard to such equine activities. If I am a parent or guardian of a participant in equine activities sponsored by VADA-CH and sanctioned by USDF at Farm, I consent to my child's participation and **AGREE** to all of the above provisions and **AGREE** to assume all of the obligations of this Release on my child's behalf.

I acknowledge that I have read the following language from the Code of Virginia relating to limited liability on equine activities which reads:

§ 3.2-6202 Liability Limited, Liability Actions Prohibited

- A. Except as provided in § 3.2-6203, an equine activity sponsor, an equine professional, or any other person who is a corporation, partnership, or limited liability company, shall not be liable for an injury to or death of a participant resulting from the intrinsic dangers of equine activities and, except as provided in § 3.2-6203, a participant nor any participant's parent, guardian, or representative shall have or make any claim against or recover from any equine activity sponsor, equine professional, or any other person for injury, loss, damage, or death of a participant resulting from any of the intrinsic dangers of equine activities.
- B. Except as provided in § 3.2-6203, no participant or parent or guardian of a participant who has knowingly executed a waiver of his rights to sue or agrees to assume all risks specifically enumerated under this subsection shall maintain an action against or recover from an equine activity sponsor or an equine professional for an injury to or the death of a participant engaged in an equine activity. The waiver shall give notice to the participant of the intrinsic dangers of equine activities. The waiver shall remain valid unless expressly revoked in writing by the participant or parent or guardian of a minor.
