OFFICE FEE: \$20 Per Entry STABLING:

-Saturday Stall Only (7am-1.5 hours after last class)=\$40.00

-Full Dressage Show ONLY (Friday-Saturday)=\$65.00

— If stalling for the full show, you may arrive after 12:00PM Friday

Stalls will be bedded – if you require additional shavings, you can buy them from the on-site show office for 7.50/bag. Additional \$25 per stall cleaning fee applied for all unpicked stalls. All stalls are inspected prior to and after the show. Damage to any wood stall will be fined at \$50 per incident.

HAUL-IN: A \$25.00 per horse fee to be charged if stall is not reserved

TEST OF CHOICE(TOC): All Test of Choice Classes are to be scored together if smaller then 6 riders

DOGS: Well-behaved dogs welcome, please clean up after your dog. ALL Dogs must be on a leash, with current ID, vaccination tags. A \$25.00 Fee will be issued for ANY dogs not on a leash.

AWARDS: Each division will be pinned separately (First-Sixth Place Ribbons)

CHAMPIONSHIPS: High Percentage, and Reserve High Percentage for each Level/Division.

COVID-19: Per USEF/USDF Guidelines, masks are required for all persons onsite unless mounted. Please observe social distancing per state guidelines, and refrain from sharing equipment exc. from other participants.

SCHOOLING: A \$35 PER DAY fee will be assessed for non-competing horses. Schooling in competing arena will be allowed from 3PM Friday until 45 minutes before commencement on the day of the show.

LUNGING: Lunging is only permitted in designated areas; prohibited on grass and in show arenas.

RULES/REGULATIONS: Each participant is responsible for knowing the USDF/EF Rules/Regulations on tack, bits, tests, and other show related topics. please visit usef.org or usdf.org with questions or come directly to the show office.

STALLIONS: All stallions must be handled by an adult over the age of 18. On site stallions are the responsibility of the owner/handler/trainer.

FOOTING: One outdoor sand arena and compaction sand indoor warm-up arena

ENTRIES: All entries MUST be submitted online at horseshowoffice.com Rides are filled as entries are received. No entries accepted without FULL payment and negative, current Coggins Test and Vaccine Record.

HELMETS: Required to be on and buckled at all times while mounted according to USEF.

POST ENTRIES: No entries will be accepted after the deadline.

REFUNDS: Full refund up to closing date other than office fee. NO refunds after closing date.

TIMES: Ride times will be posted on HorseShowOffice.com, ADA website, Rivendell Stables Facebook and Rivendellstable.com

FOOD: On site food and beverage will be available for purchase.

FACILITIES: Bathroom available on site.
